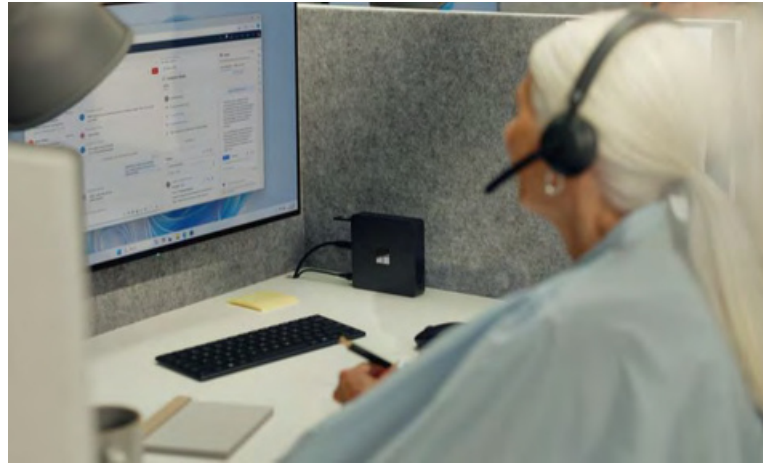

Built as a compact, fanless, lightweight device:

4.72 inches x 4.72 inches x 1.18 inches and weighs less than one pound

Boasts dual 4K monitor support with one HDMI and one DisplayPort, 3 USB-A, 1 USB-C port, a 3.5mm audio port, an Ethernet Port, Wi-Fi 6E, and Bluetooth 5.3

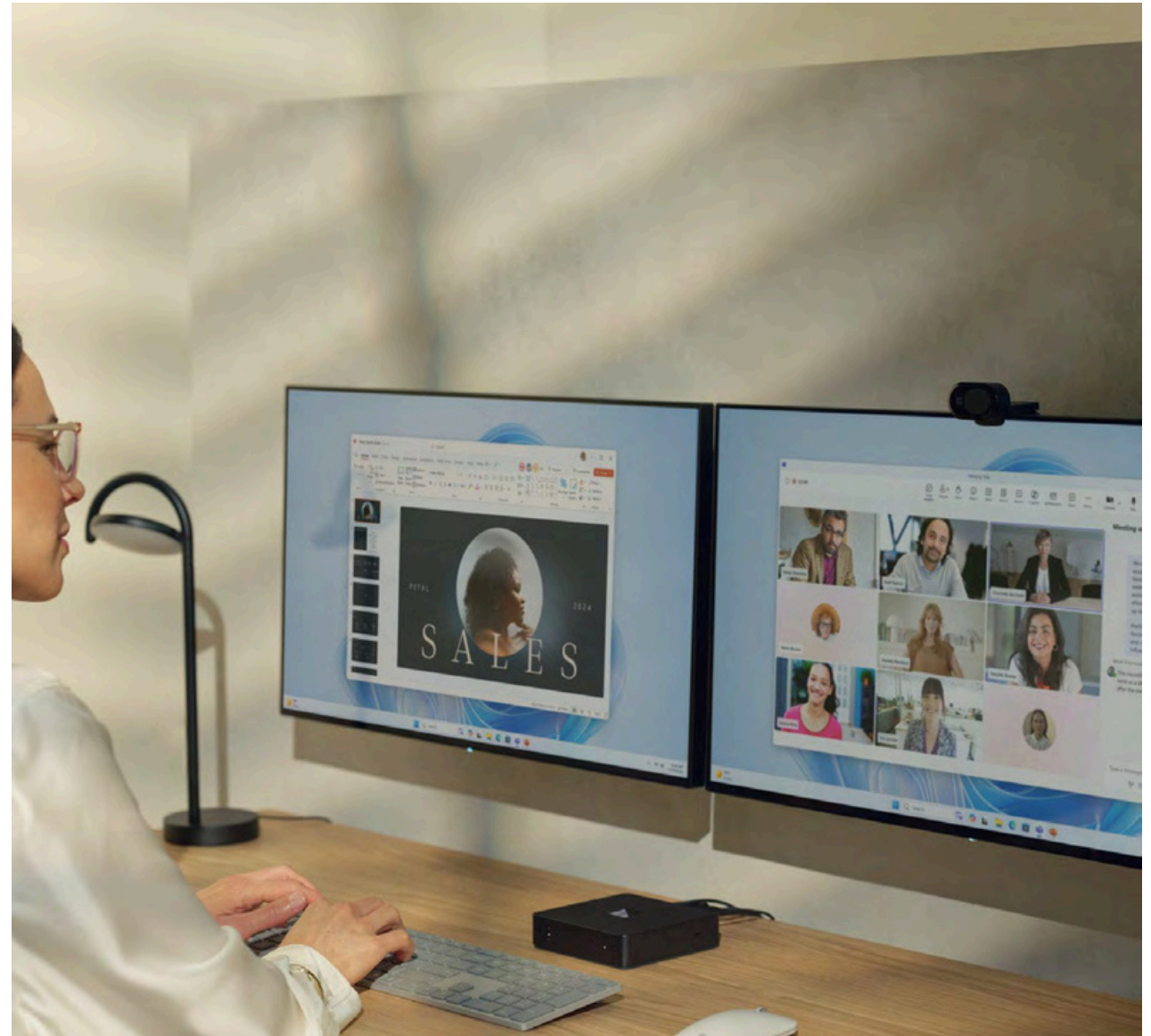

Servicing, Warranty, and Protection

Designed to be durable and repairable

Windows 365 Link is designed to be long-lasting devices will receive driver, firmware, and operating system updates¹ for at least 6 years² from when the device was first released (April 2nd, 2025).

Windows 365 Link comes with a Microsoft Limited Hardware Warranty that includes a minimum of one year of coverage for mechanical breakdown.³

Customers who want to protect their investment beyond the hardware warranty can purchase a protection plan.⁴ Microsoft Extended Hardware Service provides extended coverage for mechanical breakdown up to 2, 3, or 4 years.

Microsoft Complete for Business provides extended coverage for mechanical breakdown + accidental damage protection for up to 2, 3, or 4 years.

If the device is no longer covered by the Limited Hardware Warranty or a protection plan, customers maybe eligible for out-of-warranty service for a fee.⁵The product may be repaired or replaced depending on the available out-of-warranty offers, which vary by country.

² If the servicing period exceeds six years, an updated end-of-servicing date will be announced before the date of last servicing.
